



## Host a golden oldies music quiz for the Muscular Dystrophy Campaign

### What is it?

- The Muscular Dystrophy Campaign is celebrating their 50<sup>th</sup> year and in recognition of this you could have a golden oldies themed music quiz.
- Get a group of people together and host a fun music quiz.
- It could be a competition to find out who knows the most golden oldies with prizes for the winning team and maybe even a forfeit for the losing team.

### What you'll need

- Decide on the date and time for the event.
- Write the details of the event on your blank poster found in your fundraising pack. To order more through the **Tesco Hotline call 0845 872 9058.**
- Willing volunteers to participate and help you organise the music quiz.
- Contact the **Tesco Hotline 0845 872 9058** for some quiz questions to get you started.
- Recruit a quiz master who will be confident to read out the questions and run the quiz on the day.
- There are lots of questions available on the internet for your quiz, you may decide to have a picture round or play clips of songs.
- Recruit participants who are keen to help organise teams for the event.
- A treasurer or a safe place to keep the money throughout the event.
- A collecting box for participants to put their donations. To order more through the **Tesco Hotline call 0845 872 9058.**
- A venue for the quiz– this could be as simple as the staff restaurant or you could ask a local pub if you can use their function room free of charge.
- For prizes ask your suppliers or store managers.
- Update everyone on how much you or your team raised by displaying the amount on one of the blank posters.
- **\*Before you start any fundraising activity please check with your line manager first**

## How long it'll take

- Time to make/distribute posters and tell staff about the event.
- Allow 3-4 weeks to publicise the event to your colleagues.
- The more notice you give people of the date the more people will be able to participate.
- Invite a Muscular Dystrophy Campaign representative to attend the music quiz.
- Collect money at the start of the day from teams.
- Give the winners their prizes at the end of the quiz
- Publicise winners to all members of staff.

## Top tips

- Tell as many people as possible what you're doing to generate interest.
- Recruit as many people as possible to take part.
- Advertise the event and the fun that will be had!
- Ask your manager to remind people at any team meetings in the run up to the exciting music quiz.
- Put posters up in staff areas to let people know what you're doing, include your contact details
- Put details on your staff intranet or tell people at your staff team meeting.
- Try and generate publicity for your store/depot by contacting One Team or the local press to see if they will feature a story and photo of your event.

## Show me the money!

- Participating in the event is dependent on paying the money.
- Charge a fee for entering the Golden oldies music quiz.
- £5 is the standard suggested amount per person participating.
- Try and get your prizes donated by suppliers to save money and run a raffle if at all possible during the day.
- Bank the money for information about how you should bank the money please refer to page 7 of your fundraising pack, consult your designated charity champion or call the **Tesco Hotline 0845 872 9058**
- Bank the money. All money raised should be banked in cash reports till number 702

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- 702 for Share A Smile events.
- Update everyone on how much you or your team raised by displaying the amount on one of the blank posters or the shopping list target poster.

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
